We have around 100 boards situated at various properties around Leicester, and have recently ordered a significant amount of stock which will last us years to come. In spite of this, we as a company fully support and encourage new regulations on the use of such boards in residential areas. We have always operated primarily as an online agent, with no shop front or other significant public advertising, and as such we believe that there are far less intrusive methods of marketing properties.
